ONE-WEEK SKILL-BASED TRAINING PROGRAM FOR PROSECUTORS & INVESTIGATORS

BATCH - III : FROM 25 JAN - 30 JAN 2021



One-Week skill based training program for Prosecutors and Investigators (Batch-03) was held at Sindh Judicial Academy from 25 to 30 January 2021. Total number of participants was 22, which included 13 Prosecutors and 09 Police Officers.

Mr. Muhammad Shahid Shafiq, D&SJ/SFM, SJA conducted a training session on "Role of Prosecutor during Investigation".

Mr. Javed Ahmed Keerio, D&SJ, Sanghar conducted two consecutive skill-based sessions on "Scrutiny of Challan and Submission of Report to Magistrate", in which he explained various aspects and engaged the participants in some exercises for the better understanding of the topic.



On Day-1, **Mr. Aftab Ahmed Bajwa, Administrative Officer, SJA** conducted the inauguration session including registration and attendance of participants, recitation, a brief on Code of Conduct & SOPs and introduction of the training program.

On Day-2, first session was conducted by **Mr. Muhammad Shahid Shafiq, D&SJ/SFM, Sindh Judicial Academy**. He elaborated on the topic "How to prepare a witness for recording evidence in court (ATC Trial)".



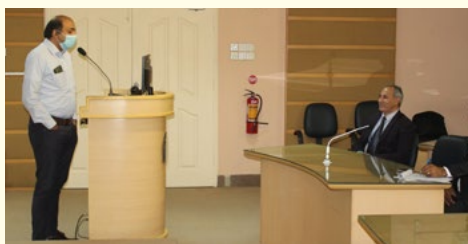
Thereafter, **Mr. Syed Waqas Shah & Mr. Aftab Shuaib**, Representatives of UNODC jointly conducted "Pre-Assessment" of the trainees and shared the "Objectives of Training".

Thereafter, **Mr. Syed Waqas Shah, Representative of UNODC** conducted second session and explained the topic "Team Building and Conflict Resolution".



Mr. Anwar Mansoor Khan, Advocate, Supreme Court of Pakistan conducted a detail training session on "Role of Prosecutor during trial". He defined the prosecution in the light of United Nations Program on Independence of Judiciary held in 2019. He also explained the working of prosecutors and investigation officers under the guidelines given in the constitution of Pakistan.

Third session was conducted by **Mr. Aftab Ahmed Bajwa, Administrative Officer, SJA** on the topic "Introduction of Forensic Science". He also covered purpose & importance as well as various types of forensic evidence.



In fourth session of Day-2, the trainees accompanied by **Mr. Aftab Ahmed Bajwa**, Administrative Officer, SJA were taken to a visit of Forensic Lab at Police Head Quarters, Garden, Karachi, where the trainees were delivered a lecture on Forensic Science and facilities available. The trainees also visited various sections of Forensic Lab (firearms section, fingerprint section, crime scene model room etc.) and briefed on spot by the experts.

in Leading Cases". He shared the similarities of the criminal justice system of Pakistan, UK and United States of America. The summary of Malala Yousufzai case was discussed including the incident, mechanism, charge and explained the Polygraphy Test. A discussion was made on Mashal Khan Case with its background.



In the final session of Day-2 **Hon'ble Mr. Justice Amjad Ali Sahito**, Judge High Court of Sindh delivered a lecture on "Role of Prosecutor during investigation & trial" and "Role of Investigator during investigation & trial".

In fifth session, **Mr. Justice Hassan Feroze**, Former Judge High Court of Sindh delivered a lecture on "How to Argue Bail Application?" He shared the fundamentals involved in arguing and explained the facts in brief.



On Day-4, **Mr. Khalid Hussain Shahani**, D&SJ, Karachi East, delivered a lecture on "Exploring and analyzing Internet Crimes and their behaviours" and "Use of electronic devices during investigation". He also shared the legal aspects of this specific investigation.



On Day-3, the trainees accompanied by **Mr. Aftab Ahmed Bajwa**, Administrative Officer, SJA were taken to a visit of DNA Lab/ICCBS at Karachi University, where the trainees were delivered a lecture on DNA and facilities available. The trainees also visited various sections of DNA Lab and were briefed on spot by the experts.

Thereafter, **Mr. Syed Waqas Shah**, Representative of UNODC conducted second & third sessions and explained the topics "Police and Prosecution cooperation" and "Communication skills".



Third & fourth sessions were conducted by Additional Prosecutor, Peshawar High Court, Peshawar on "Sharing Good Practices followed

In fourth session, **Mr. Abdul Naeem Memon**, District & Sessions Judge conducted lecture on "Apex Court



decisions on grant of pre and post arrest bail". He also conducted a few exercises on the topic.

Thereafter, a lecture was delivered by **Dr. Talib Lashari**, Technical Advisor, CIP Population Welfare Department, Govt. of Sindh on the topic "Orientation on Dynamics of Population Growth". He explained the importance & requirement of balancing population growth and briefed on the related laws, policies and obligations.



On Day-5, **Ch. Muhammad Jahangir**, Director, CPD Punjab and **Mr. Abu Bakar Nauman**, Deputy Prosecutor, Government of Punjab, Lahore jointly conducted two consecutive sessions. They shared the knowledge on "Defective Prosecution and its effect on final verdicts".



Third session was conducted by **Mr. Muhammad Shahid Shafiq**, D&SJ/SFM, Sindh Judicial Academy, he defined the Juvenile Justice System Act, 2018 and its implementation issues.

Thereafter, **Hon'ble Mr. Justice Muhammad Iqbal Kalhoro**, Judge High Court of Sindh, in his session, delivered a lecture on "General Role of Prosecutor in Trial". He emphasized on producing the natural witness in front of the court and also stressed that nobody should be harassed in the process of evidence. The Hon'ble Judge also conducted a mock trial with Trainees Presentation.

In fifth session, **Mr. Faizullah Korejo**, Addl. Director, Cyber Crime

Circle, FIA, delivered a lecture on "Cyber Crime". He elaborated on "Exploring and analyzing Internet Crimes and their behaviours" and "Gathering digital forensic evidence, related laws, case laws". He also discussed various legal aspects, implementation issues and explained various guidelines & strategies.

On Day-6, the first session was conducted by **Mr. Abdul Razzaq**, Registrar, High Court of Sindh on "Law of Probation". He shared that the current probation system was originated from legislation introduced in the country in 1960. He also shared that the Probation may apply to convicts of any age but is excluded in the case of specified serious offences. He discussed various provisions alongwith case examples.

In second & third session, **Mr. Muhammad Shahid Shafiq**, D&SJ/SFM, SJA delivered a detailed lecture on "Anti-Money Laundering and Counter Terrorism Financing". He elaborated on related laws, case laws, implementation issues and various guidelines / SOPs.

In fourth session, **Syed Faiz Shah**, Prosecutor General Sindh, conducted a lecture on salient features of "The Sindh Witness Protection Act, 2013" and "Role of Investigation Officer and Prosecutor in protecting witnesses". He shared that it provides protection of witnesses to enable them to give evidence in criminal proceedings in the Province of Sindh.



In the final session, post assessment test was conducted. The participants were also given a Trainer evaluation for assessing the performance of honorable trainers.

In the concluding remarks, **Hon'ble Director General Sindh Judicial Academy, Mr. Justice Muhammad Ali Mazhar, Judge High Court of Sindh** shared that Prosecutors and Investigation Officers play a very vital role in dispensing justice. He also shared that the judges cannot

properly accomplish their tasks in case of flaws in prosecution and investigation. The Honorable DG also shared that hopefully this one-week on job adult learning training program would be very useful for their professional and career development. He said that such courses are aimed to enhance learning curiosity among the professionals and that is the main role of Sindh Judicial Academy. He urged that all judicial fraternity should collaborate with each other

so that the goal of dispensation of justice may be properly achieved. Later, the representatives of trainees presented souvenirs to the Honorable Director General, Prosecutor General, Sindh and Faculty Members of Sindh Judicial Academy.

On conclusion, the certificates were awarded to the trainees followed by a group photograph.
