One-Week Training Program on Human Rights for Newly Appointed **Civil Judges & Judicial Magistrates**

(17 - 22 JULY 2023)

Salient Proceedings

Br. Rida **Tahir** (Advocate High Court of Sindh) delivered а presentation "Gender on Mainstreaming." She explained problem the context, legislation, and future policy options.
