Three-Day Training Program on Gender-Based Violence for Civil Judges/Judicial Magistrates and Prosecutors (29 - 31 AUGUST 2023, BATCH-04)



- The rise of Gender-Based Violence (GBV) offenses that are coming to light brings about fresh hurdles, underlining the need for a fundamental grasp of GBV matters. To meet these challenges head-on, it was essential to adequately equip the judiciary and prosecution with knowledge about GBV crimes. This involved imparting training and education to boost their understanding, abilities, strategies for response, empowering them to tackle and counteract these emerging patterns of violence adeptly.
- The Sindh Judicial Academy collaboration with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) arranged a "Three-Day Training of Trainers on GBV" for 06 Civil Judges & Judicial Magistrates and 17 Prosecutors (Batch-04) from 29 - 31 August 2023 at Sindh Judicial Academy, Karachi.
